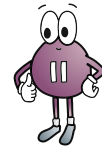

STORY 1: Noah obeys God

This story is about Noah building the Ark.



READ:
Genesis 6: 5-22

Adult Guidance - Talk about the animals in the picture and see how many the children can name. Explain that in today's story God asked Noah to build an Ark. Noah obeyed God.

The people God had made were not obeying His rules. This made God sad. God decided to punish these people by sending a big flood.

But God was pleased with Noah, because he loved and obeyed God. God told Noah to build a big boat which is called an Ark. This would keep the animals and his family safe.

Colour the big boat (or Ark) brown.
Put a circle around Noah.



STORY 2: Safe in the Ark

This story is about when the flood started.

Adult Guidance - Talk about things adults do to make sure children are kept safe. God kept Noah and his family safe in the Ark.

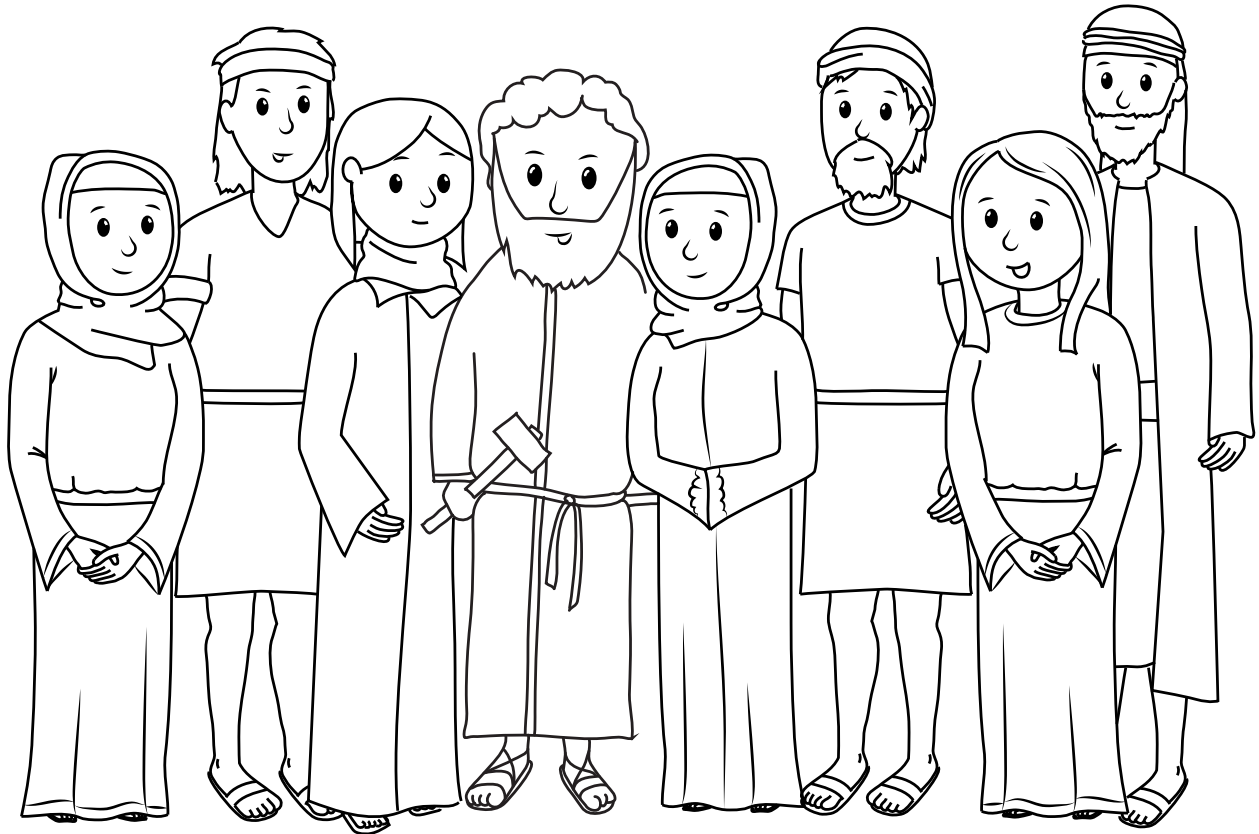


READ:
Genesis 7: 1-16

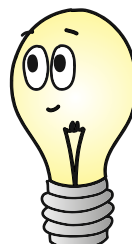
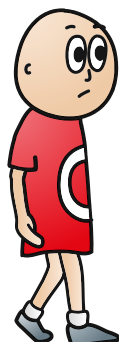
God told Noah to go into the Ark. Noah went into the Ark with all the animals and his family. Then God shut the door.

This story is about when the flood finished.

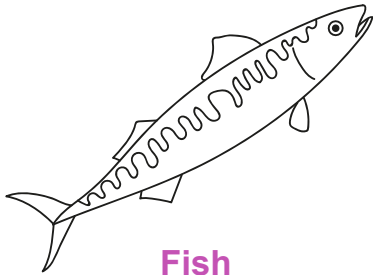
Adult Guidance - Explain how we trust people we know. Can the children think of examples? Explain that Noah trusted God and that he was kept safe.

Noah then knew that the flood had ended.

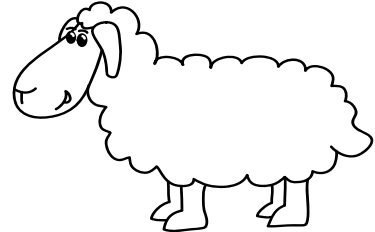
Circle the bird which Noah sent out from the Ark.

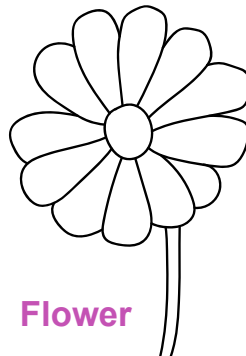

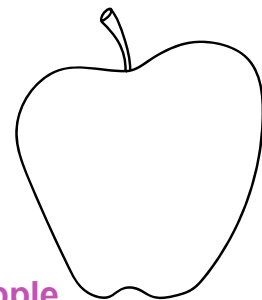
Colour the item the dove brought back to the Ark.

The dove had a special job to do for Noah. Isn't it amazing to think about how clever God's creation is?

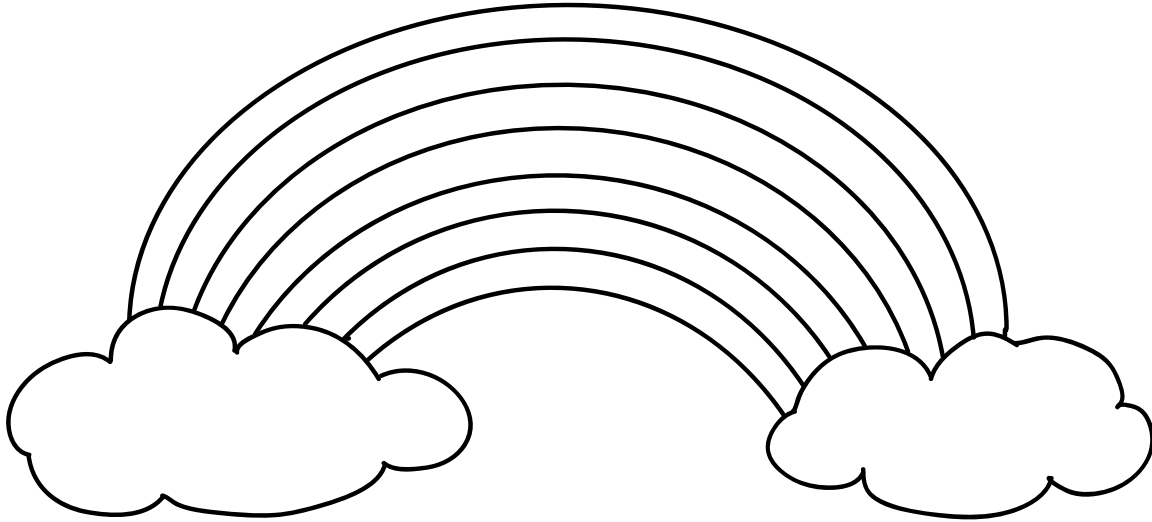
STORY 4: God's promise

This story is about the rainbow.



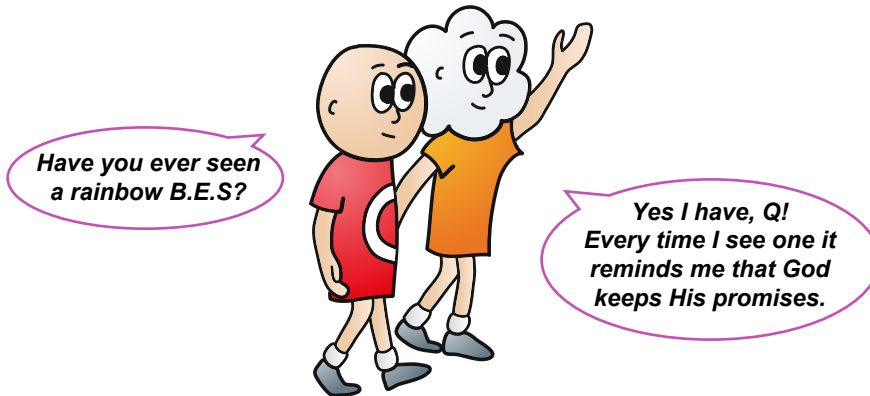
Adult Guidance - Talk about what a promise is. Sometimes it's difficult to keep our promises. The Bible says that God always keeps His promises.
